- 3) Counts may differ from previous periods due to system updates and post-adjudicative outcomes.
- 4) Approvals reflect the initial decision on a case. The case may have been reopened and revoked at a later date.
- 5) Family Member counts use Performance Reporting Tool data for fiscal years 2009-2012. System data is incomplete prior to 2013.
- 6) Congress set a cap of 10,000 visas per year. Principal petitioners only are counted against the cap; derivatives are not counted toward the annual cap of 10,000 visas.  
Due to certain errors in USCIS adjudicative systems, a small number of cases each year may be inaccurately excluded from the total cap count resulting in slight overages.
